AMENDMENT 3

4.5 Qualification process – Added text

The qualification process for the CHAMPIONSHIP RACE will be as follows:

- Lone qualifier
 - Session will end automatically after 10 minutes
 - Maximum of 4 timed laps
- Laps must not be finished once the session has ended.

AMENDMENT 4

6.1 Penalties – Added text

P04 – Stop and Hold Penalty (0-60 seconds)
Race control is able to give out S/H penalties between 0 and 60 seconds.

AMENDMENT 5

9.2 Communication – Deleted and added text

Voice communication 'in-game' must be kept to a minimum at all

times, but particularly during qualifying and the race. This includes the use of macro text options being 'spammed' in driver chat, as well as turning on voice communication button, even if nothing is said.

In particular, it is not acceptable to argue with other drivers over voice or text chat in sim, during or after, the race. There will be appropriate channels where grievances can be raised to Race Control, and it is not fair on other drivers to race in the middle of an argument. Failure to comply will result in a driver's in-game chat being disabled.

Use of the in-game chat function integrated in iRacing is not permitted during all official qualifying and race sessions.

AMENDMENT 6

10.4 Practice – Added text

The server for the Championship Race gets a second open practice between 19:45 CET and 20:45 CET. Race control will open and close the track for the practice sessions.
